



Protest at G4S AGM

The last twelve months have seen G4S voted third 'Worst Company of the Year' in the global Public Eye awards, they also face a UK parliamentary inquiry into their disastrous handling of an asylum housing contract and will soon give evidence at the inquest into the death of Jimmy Mubenga who died while being restrained by G4S staff. Not that you would know it from the self-congratulatory tone of G4S' latest Corporate Responsibility Report.

Across Europe, G4S are becoming a pariah company as trade unions, charities and faith groups take a public stand in opposing its drive to put private profit above human rights. Organisations in the Middle East have called for a boycott of G4S due to their complicity with Israel's repression

The inquest into the death of Jimmy Mubenga (who was restrained by three G4S guards on a plane at Heathrow in 2010) starts on 13 May 2013 and is expected to last eight weeks. The family of Jimmy Mubenga is calling for people to attend to show support. G4S guards are likely to be giving evidence on 15/16/17 May 2013.
