After retiring as rector of St James Piccadilly in 1998, **Donald Reeves MBE** turned his formidable talents to the complex and demanding work of international peace-building. Donald is co-founder and director of **Soul of Europe**, an NGO working as a mediation body in Bosnia, Kosovo and Serbia and beyond, preparing the ground for the possibilities of reconciliation. Peace-building is demanding, exhausting work. Faced with constant denial, rage and suffering, peace-building requires tenacity, patience, dignity and a willingness to take risks. Amidst all these difficulties Donald has found that Bach's music is immeasurably life-enhancing, a testimony to the gift of hope for the human spirit.

In the glowing atmosphere of Union Chapel, Donald will speak about his experiences and future plans as a peace-builder, interspersed with playing Bach's Chorale Preludes on the Chapel's magnificent newly restored Henry Willis organ.
